Celebrating the Spirit of Volunteerism

The Volunteer of the Year Awards Celebration has become the River Region's largest annual event recognizing individuals and groups who have given selflessly of their time and talent to improve their community and the overall quality of life. The awards celebration is held each year during National Volunteer Week in April – this year we will celebrate 48 years of recognizing those in the River Region who affect change in their community.

Awards

Awards are given to outstanding individual volunteers and volunteer groups whose efforts have brought about a positive impact on the River Region.

Categories (Eligible for Nominations):

- Adult Group Groups eligible for this award represent colleges, civic organizations, faith-based groups, or corporations.
 Consideration is given to the groups' collective approach to problem solving and improving the community.
- Adult Volunteer (Ages 19 64) Individuals eligible for this
 award may be involved in a variety of community activities or may
 have a concentration of service with a particular cause. The
 collective effect of their work has an impact on agencies and the
 community at large. Consideration is given to the nominee's
 longevity, focus or variety of work, and overall impact.
- Senior Volunteer (Age 65+) Individuals eligible for this award have participated in hands-on, direct service with one or more agencies. Their service is considered extraordinary.
 Consideration is given to the nominee's longevity, focus, and impact to the agency, its constituents, and/or the community.



- Youth Group (18 & under) Groups eligible for this award may represent schools, faith-based organizations, or service clubs. Consideration is given to the group's team approach to problem solving and improving the community.
- Youth Volunteer (18 & under) This award recognizes a youth who incorporates volunteerism into his/her life and serves as an inspiration to others.

2021 VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD RECIPIENTS

Adult: Patrick Aitken, an everyday hero and champion for the over 800 homeless living in the River Region.

Adult Group: Autauga County Master Gardeners Association, which maintains two community gardens, donates 1,000 pounds of produce annually to low-income families and presents programs in schools and libraries to pass along their love of gardening to future generations.

Youth: Tionna Tate, an honor graduate of LAMP who established and led the school's FOCUS Program to raise awareness about social issues focusing primarily on mental health matters.

Youth Group: The Philanthropy 101 program at the Montgomery Academy who participate in a summer course that challenges them to question their abilities to make a difference in the community. The group visits a variety of nonprofit agencies offering hands on service as well as a financial donation.

Senior Volunteer: Gloria Jean Williams, the Founder/Director of SKIP, whose life mission is to provide educational and enrichment services to at-risk children of incarcerated parents and to stop the cycle of incarceration.


